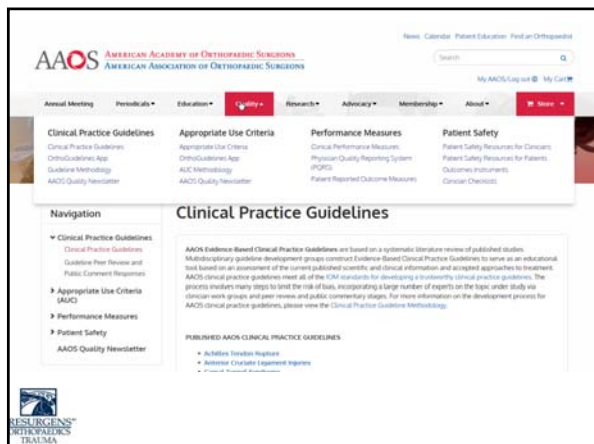


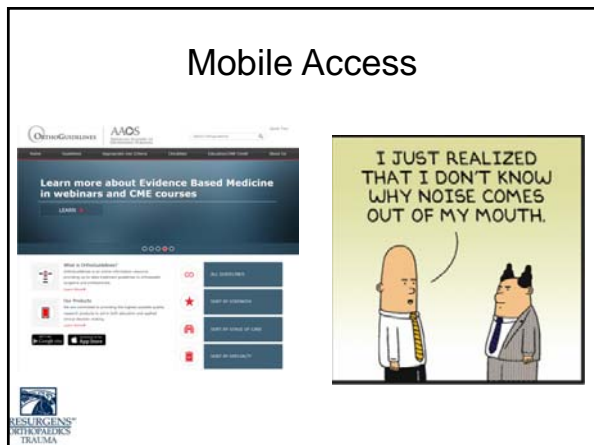


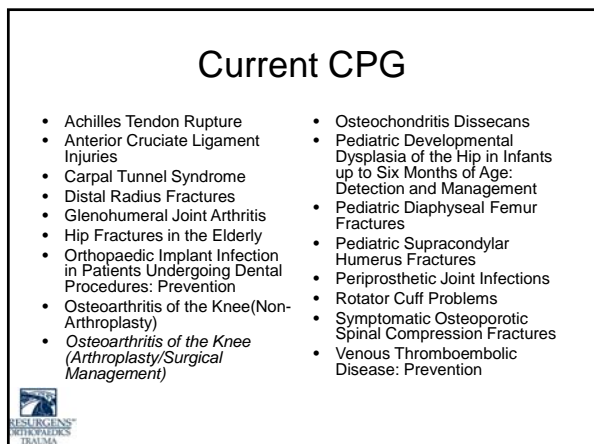
CPG vs. AUC vs. PM vs. SR

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CPG <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – “systematically developed statements to assist practitioner and patient decisions about appropriate health care for specific clinical circumstances” • AUC <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – “specify when it is appropriate to use a procedure” 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PM <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – “organized quantified measures to document performance in quality” • SR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – “thorough, comprehensive, and explicit way of assessing the medical literature on a particular topic or topics”
